Position: Diversion Equipment Operator (Contract)

Description:

The primary duties of a Diversion Equipment Operator is to operate the Facilities' loaders, forklifts, baling and other processing equipment used in the receiving, processing and shipping of diversion materials.

Responsibilities:

- Performs all the duties of a Diversion Equipment Operator.
- Generally works on own with some contact with co-workers and customers delivering materials.
- Assists in the processing of recyclables and organics including loading conveyor belts, monitoring quality, presorting materials and the processing of organic material (i.e. Windrow Management including turning and watering).
- Ensures appropriate records related to daily equipment checks and servicing, and incident and hazard reports are completed.

Qualifications:

- Equivalent to high school education with some degree of specialization in equipment operation and maintenance.
- Minimum 6 months experience with various kinds of equipment and rolling stock.
- Must have a satisfactory driver's abstract.
- Must have a valid DZ license and experience with roll-off trucks/tandem axle dump trucks.
- Must have a general knowledge of recyclable, organic and waste materials for proper sorting and waste classification. A working knowledge of composting operations would be considered an asset.
